Where: Nasson Room—downstairs in the Anderson Learning Center, 21 Bradeen Street, Springvale, ME

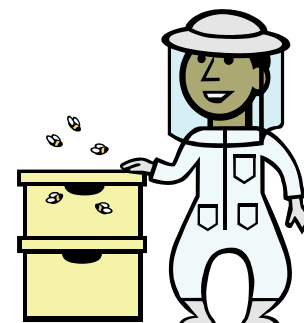
When: Monday evenings 6:00 to 8:30 PM, February 22—March 29, 2010
